Policy Title: **Educational Placement of Students  
With Special Needs**

Policy No. **6.06**

**RATIONALE:** The Board recognizes that Connect Charter School's primary mandate is to develop exemplary teaching and learning practices that meet the needs of learners. At the same time it is recognized that the educational requirements of some special needs students may be best accommodated in educational settings that offer a wider range of supports and programs than are available within the Connect Charter School.

**POLICY** The Board of Connect Charter School is committed to providing a supportive, inclusive learning environment that strives to meet individual learning needs and provide opportunities for each student to achieve success.

### **PRINCIPLES:**

1. Educational placements shall be determined by the Principal and teacher(s) in consultation with the parents or guardians of students identified with special needs, where appropriate.
2. Every effort will be made to accommodate the individual learning needs of students and to help each student experience success within the resource capacity of the school
3. Where a particular student's special needs would be better served through a specialized program in another school the student and family shall be counseled and referred accordingly.
4. The school may engage in a variety of diagnostic and clinical testing to help determine the nature of any learning disabilities that may affect a student's success within the program. Such testing may be done through school personnel and/or the family may be referred to a professional outside of the school for testing and appropriate intervention. Written consent will be obtained from parents prior to any testing or assessments.
5. The Connect Charter School building and grounds will be barrier-free
